### **Fairmount Volunteer Minimum Requirements:**

- 9 shifts a quarter. 1 shift = 12 hours in the seat. Consecutive shifts are acceptable
- 48 hours of in-house training a year

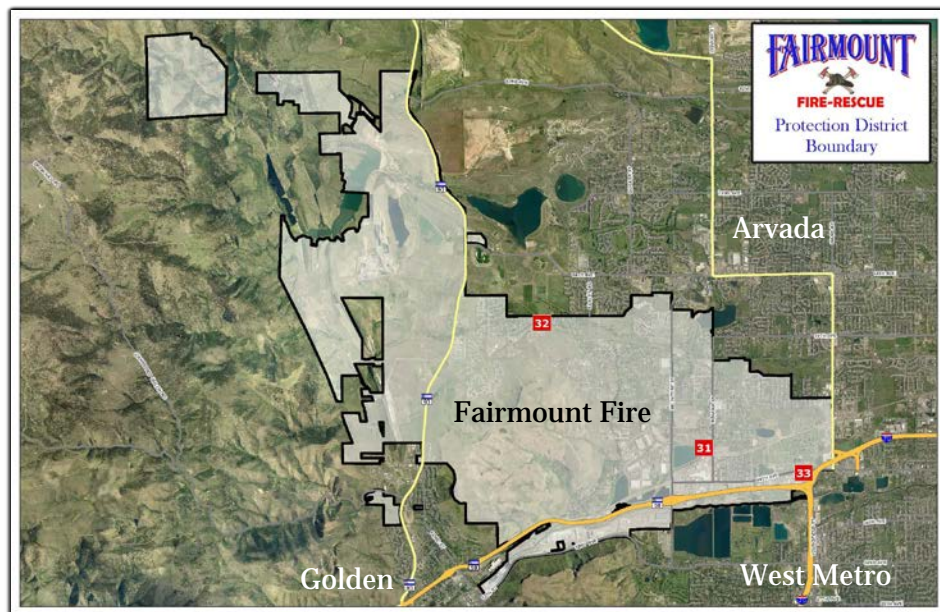

## General Info:

- **Volunteer probationary firefighters receive \$40 per 12 hour shift**
- **Once the probationary year is complete, the volunteer will receive \$70 per 12 hour shift**
- 26 square miles (see map below)
- Neighboring fire departments include Arvada, West Metro, Golden and Pleasant View
- 18,000 night time residents/30,000 day time civilians in district
- Nationally Accredited Department since 2019 (of the 29,000 plus fire departments throughout the United States, there are less than 300 departments that are Nationally Accredited)
- Other Nationally Accredited departments include West Metro, Denver, South Metro, and Aurora Fire Departments
- ISO Rating 1
- Wildland deployment available for ALL Volunteers with compensation
